# Tentative Rollout



If all goes to plan, the release schedule is shown below. However, all dates are subject to change.

**Retail** – in three batches. 9 April (5k), 15 April (20k) and 18 April (balance)

**Telstra** – 22 April

**Aussie Broadband and Dodo / iPrimus** – 22 April

**Optus** – 24 April

**iiNet / Westnet / Internode / Adam** – 26 April

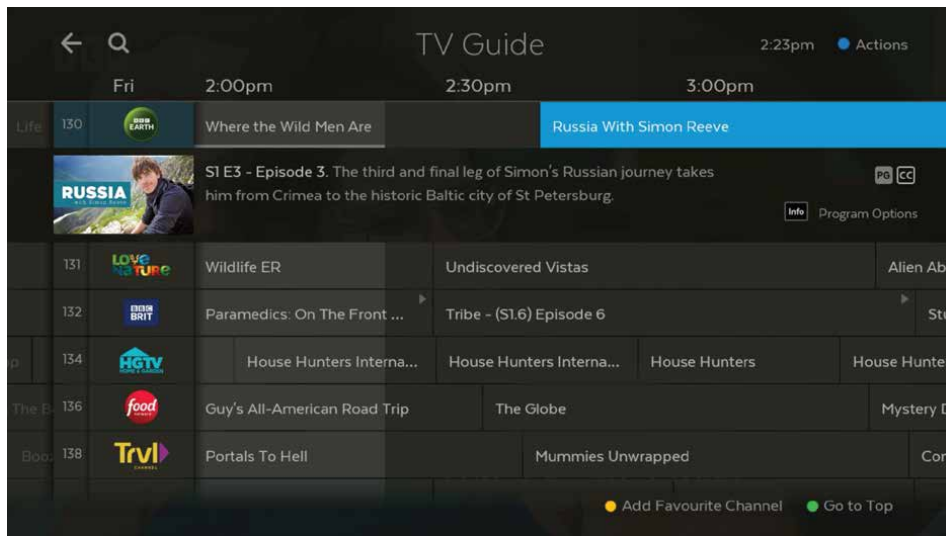
Boxes should automatically update within 72 hours of the release to each Retail / ISP grouping. Customers can reboot their Fetch box for immediate access once the roll out to their service provider has started.

All Fetch boxes (excluding Gen 2 hardware) are expected to have updated to the release by 30 April.

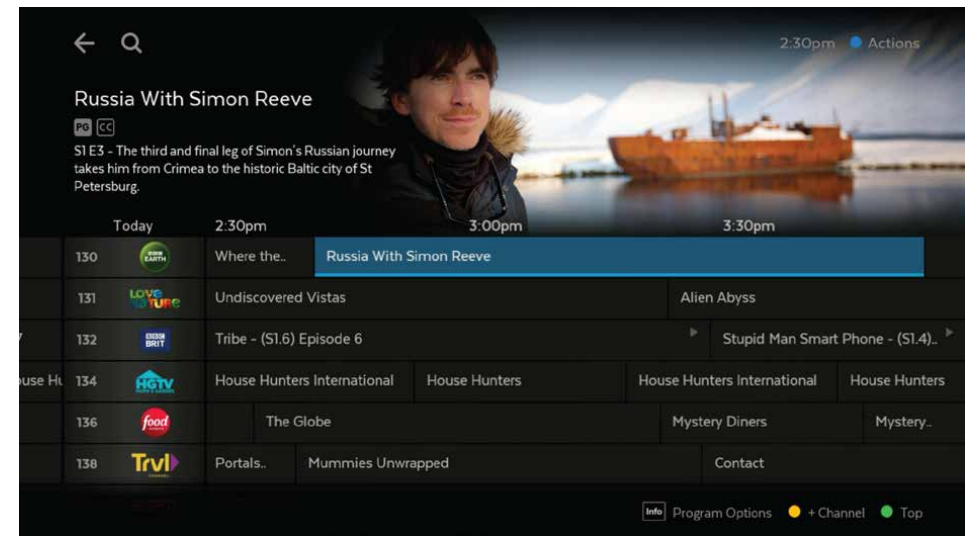
# Updated TV Guide - Program details

- The TV Guide has been rebuilt using the Lightning framework, delivering a smoother scrolling action.
- Program details are now displayed at the top of the screen for improved visibility and access to show and movie information.
- Although it looks different, the functionality of the Guide remains unchanged.
- The same amount of channels are displayed on screen at one time.

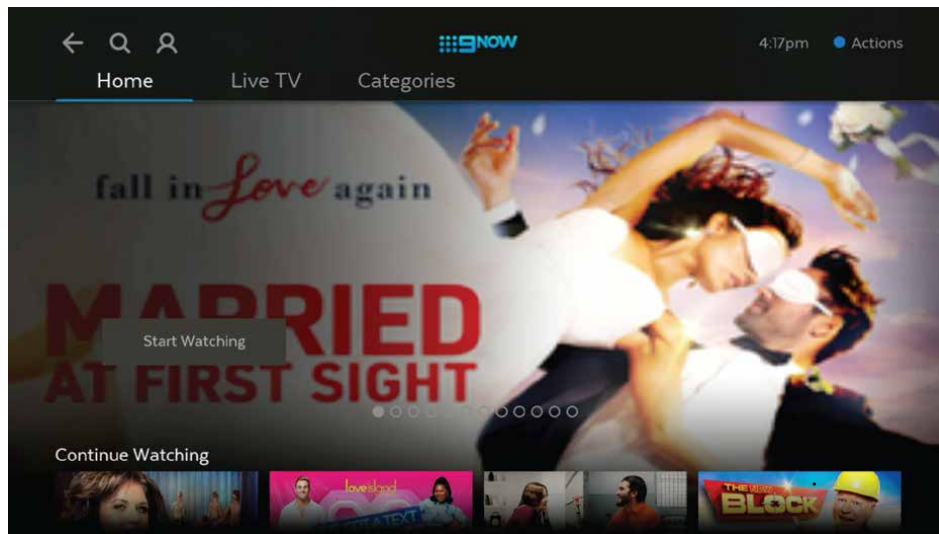


# 9Now app updates - Home page (visible soon)

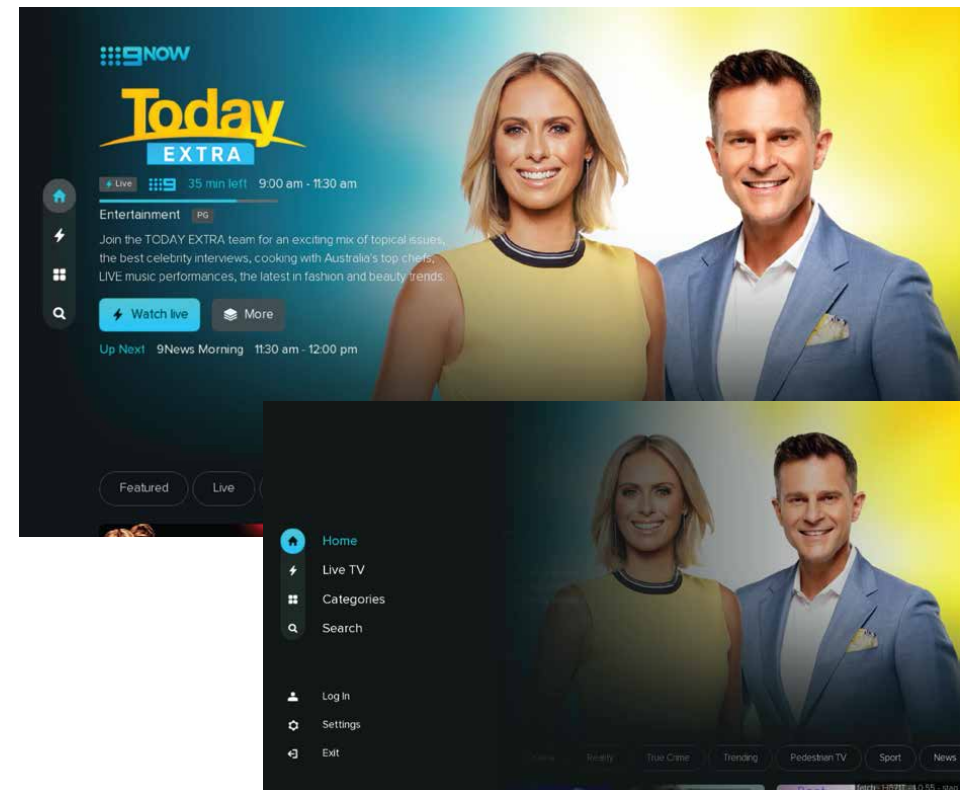


- The main feature of the redesign replaces the horizontal menu bar with a left aligned vertical menu bar, category buttons and icons.

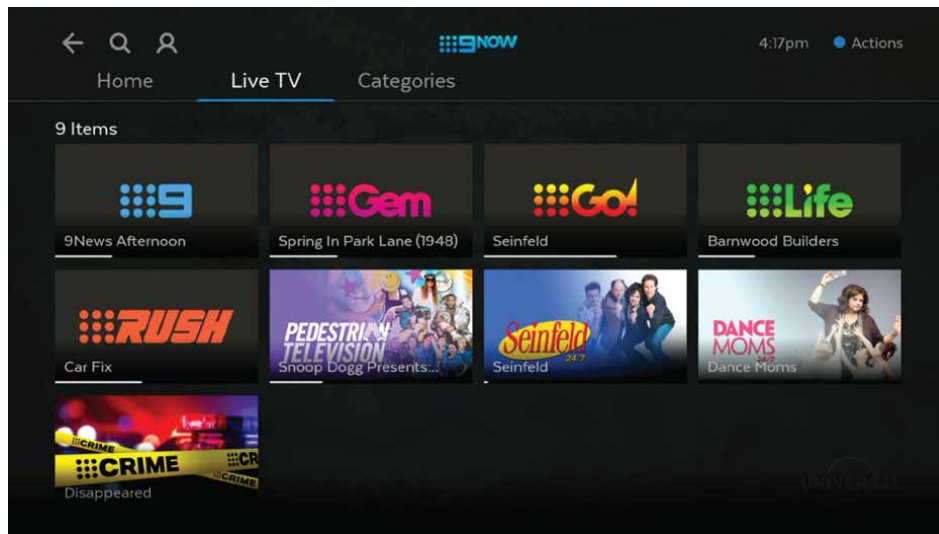


# 9Now app updates - Live page (visible soon)

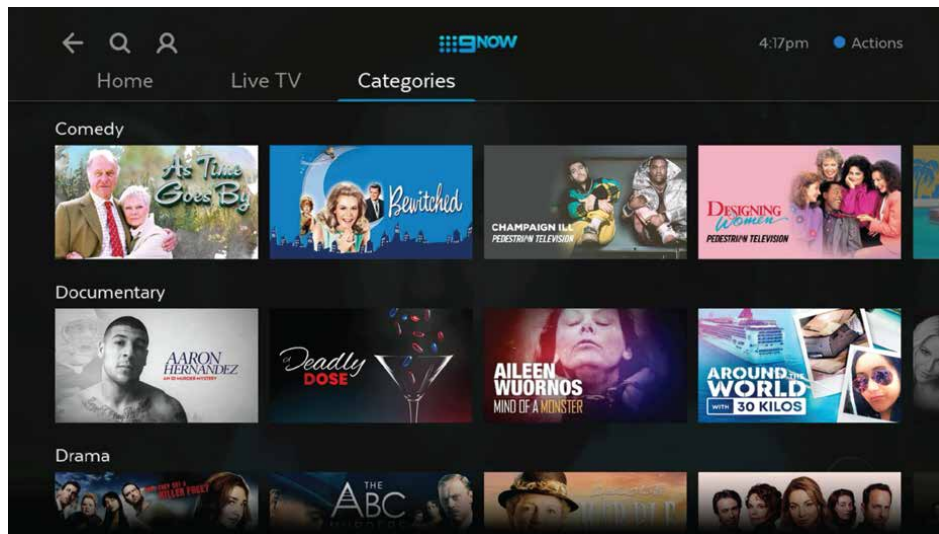
There are now two touch points to reach Live TV content.

# 9Now app updates - Categories page (visible soon)

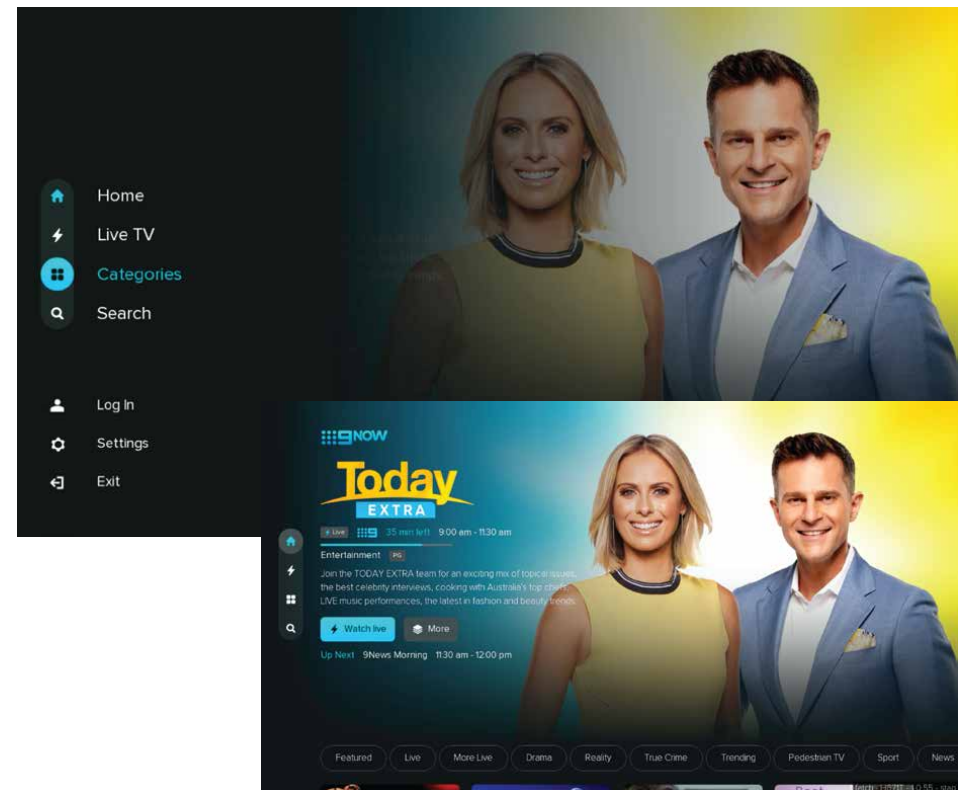

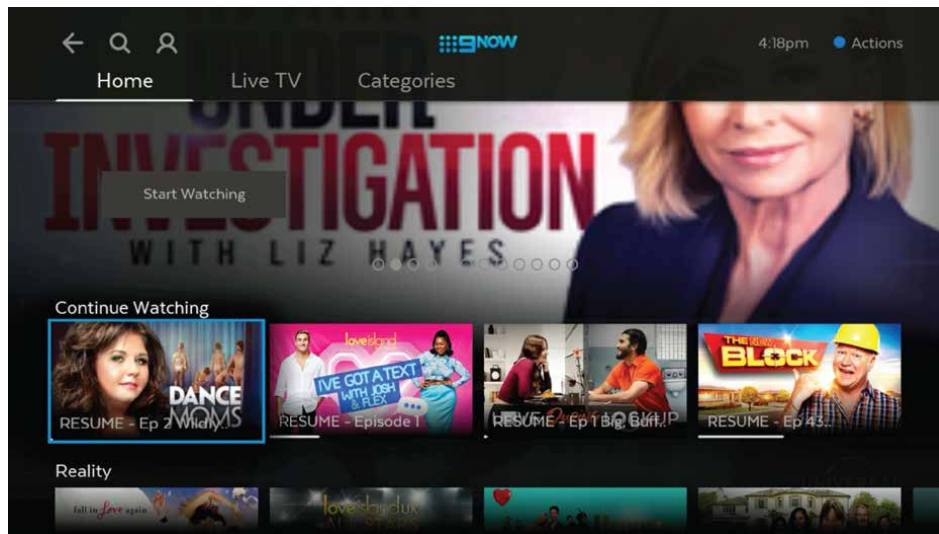


# 9Now app updates - Continue Watching (visible soon)

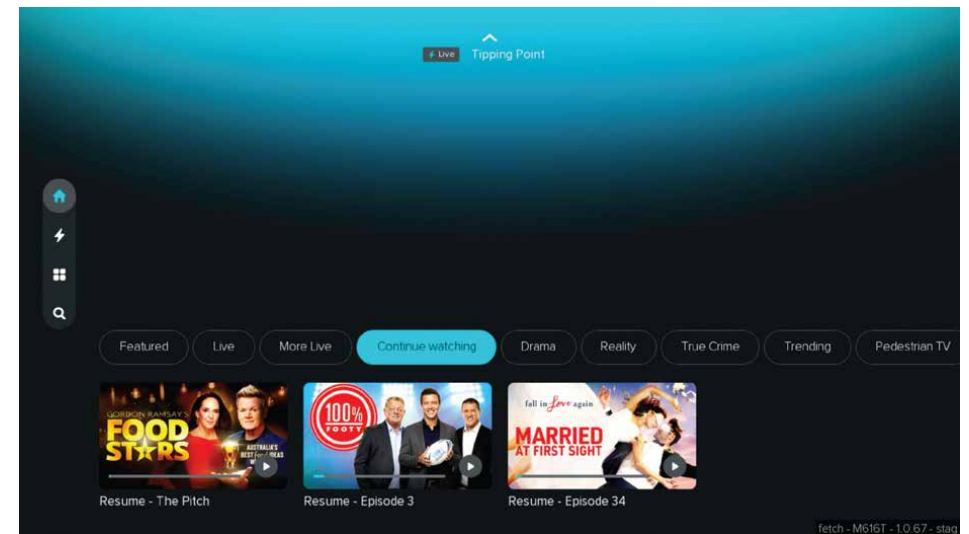

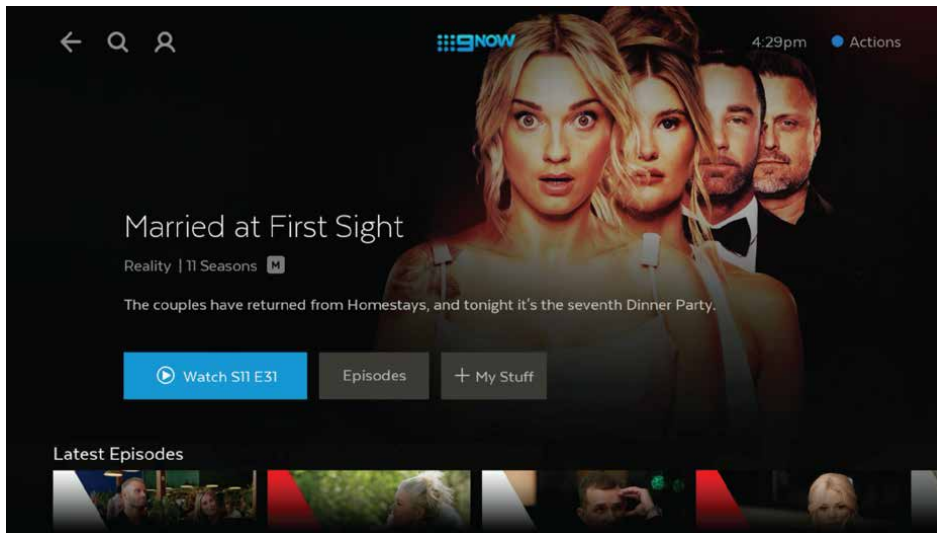


# 9Now app updates - Show details (visible soon)

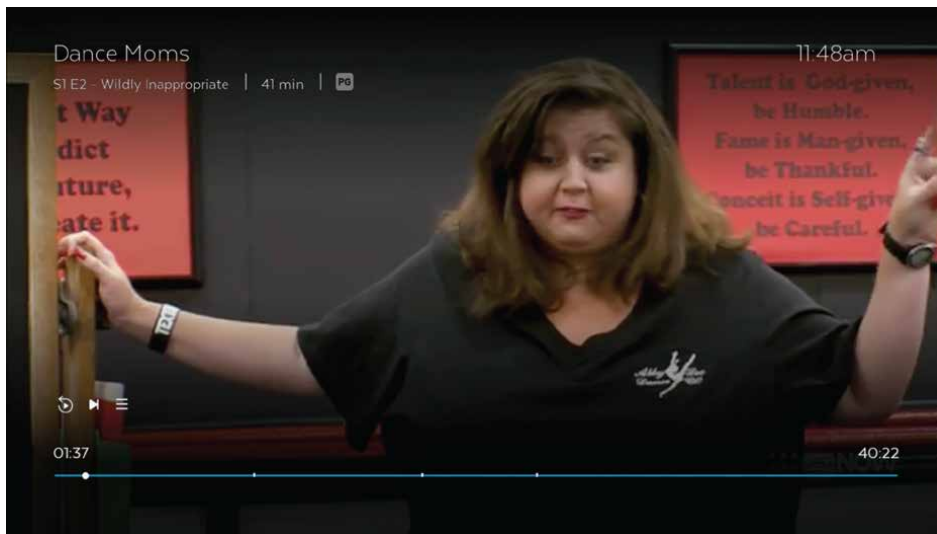


# 9Now app updates - Playing content (visible soon)
